They were selected out of a group of 70 players.

The national championships will be held at Coffs Harbour in NSW from September 29 to October 7.

Club spokeswoman Jan O'Brien said to have 11 players selected for two of the State teams was a "fantastic" achievement for the club.

Football West education and development manager Andrew Bettell said the coaching staff were excited by the prospects of their charges and looked forward to positive outcomes.

It has been a successful season for junior teams at the Cockburn City Soccer Club, with the under-14 team finishing third on its league table and the under-15s finishing first.
